## CONTINUED USE OF TWO EXISTING STATIC ADVERTISING SIGNS ON THE PEDESTRIAN OVERBRIDGE HUME HIGHWAY. STRATHFIELD

Reference is made to the referral from the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (**DPH&I**) for the abovementioned Development Application (**DA**) dated 5 November 2024 which was referred to Transport for NSW (**TfNSW**) for comment.

TfNSW notes that the DA proposes the continued display of two existing static backlit signs that were approved by the Department of Planning and Environment (now DPH&I). This proposal seeks to continue the operation of the existing approved advertising signage for a further 15 years with no physical works proposed to the signage structure.

TfNSW has no objections to the DA subject to the following conditions being included in any Development Consent issued:

- 1. The signs shall comply with applicable requirements in the Transport Corridor Outdoor Advertising and Signage Guidelines 2017 (Guidelines).
- 2. The sign images displayed must:
  - Not contain/use complex images including text and information that hold a driver's attention beyond "glance appreciation".
  - Not contain/use images resembling traffic control devices by use of colour, shape or words that can be
    construed as giving instruction to traffic for example, red, amber, or green circles, octagons, crosses,
    triangles, and words such as 'stop' or 'halt'.
  - Not contain/use dominant use of colours red or green
  - Be static in nature.
- 3. A Road Occupancy Licence (ROL) should be obtained from Transport Management Centre for any works that may impact on traffic flows to the classified road network. A ROL can be obtained through https://myrta.com/oplinc2/pages/security/oplincLogin.jsf.
