Dear Mr Harrold

I refer to the Flood Evacuation Management Plan (FEMP) submitted to the Planning Secretary in accordance with Conditions B4 of Schedule 2 of development consent DA21/15298 for the construction and operation of a helipad at Penrith Lakes.

The Department of Planning and Environment has undertaken a review of the document and considers it satisfies Condition B4 of the development consent. The Planning Secretary therefore approves the FEMP subject to the following:

- Formal training is undertaken for all staff on the evacuation strategy and likely timeframe available for evacuation;
- Signage should be installed at key locations within the site with clearly labelled directions of travel in the event of a flooding emergency. Flood evacuation plans must be clear and visible at all entry/exit points of the site;
- Flood evacuation route maps are prepared and printed for distribution to patrons when an evacuation is announced;
- The FEMP is regularly reviewed, evaluated and exercised (drills).
