BRIEFING MATTER

PPSSSH-120 - Canterbury-Bankstown - DA-650/2022 - 373 Horsley Road, Milperra

Demolition of existing structures, remediation of land, site preparation works and construction of 2 warehouse buildings for use as a warehouse and distribution centre including associated site servicing works, hardstand and landscaped areas, car parking, and supporting infrastructure. This application is Nominated Integrated Development and requires the issuing of a controlled activity approval from the Department of Planning and Environment - Water and may require an aquifer interference approval from Water NSW, under the Water Management Act 2000.

KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

The Panel notes the key issues raised in Council's Briefing Note, in particular the following matters should be considered:

- Clarification of flood planning levels and access to Council's stormwater asset required as this may result in significant design changes;
- Reducing the size of warehouses and increasing setback of the northern carpark to enable the development to meet DCP objectives for a riparian zone and provide better landscaping, outdoor amenity and ground level staff facilities;
- Reduction in the number of car spaces that exceed DCP requirements to provide increased landscaping and ground level staff facilities;
- Additional environmental and sustainability principles, eg. installation of solar panels on the roof.
