Dear Mr Devery,

RE: Notification of Activity - Cowra Hospital Redevelopment - 64 Liverpool, Cowra

NSW Health Infrastructure (HI), is proposing to redevelop the Cowra Health Service at 64 Liverpool, Cowra (Lot 2 DP1169527) to construct a new health services facility.

While this proposal does not require development consent from Council, we are required to assess its likely impacts in accordance with Part 5 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979. In accordance with Section 2.62 and 2.10(1)(a), (c), (d) and (f) of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021, we are notifying Council of our intention to carry out the activity and ask that you provide any comments on the proposal within 21 days from the date of this letter. These comments will then be considered in our assessment of the proposal.

For your information, a plan indicating the location and extent of the work is enclosed. Generally, the proposed activity comprises:

- Site preparation and earthworks.
- Removal of selected trees whose removal is a necessary outcome to facilitate the proposed works.
- Construction of a two-storey health services facility at the site's rear.
- Staged demolition of the existing main Cowra Health services building and associated structures at the site's front following the construction of the new health services facility.
- Construction of a new car park in the location of the demolished main Cowra Health services building.
- Installation and realignment of selected services, including a new sewerage connection to the Council's sewerage system.
- Installation of ancillary development including, but not limited to, lighting, signage, stormwater management and fencing.
- Site-wide landscaping strategy.

Ahead of the redevelopment which is planned to start in the first half of 2023, the nearest affected neightbours and Cowra Council will soon receive notice of some site establishment works and demolition of structures to the rear of the hospital. Site establishment will commence in December 2022 and demolition of buildings behind the existing hospital in early 2023.


