NSW Health Infrastructure (HI), is proposing to construct a new ambulance station at 771 Cudgen Road, Cudgen, NSW 2487 (Lot 11 DP 1269398). The ambulance station will be delivered through the Rural Ambulance Infrastructure Reconfiguration (RAIR) program.

While this proposal does not require development consent from Council or the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE), we are required to assess the likely impacts of the proposal in accordance with Part 5 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. In accordance with the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021*, we are notifying occupiers of adjoining and adjacent properties of our intention to undertake the works and ask that you provide any comments on the proposal within 21 days from the date of this letter. These comments will then be considered in our assessment of the proposal.

For your information, plans showing the location and extent of the work are enclosed. Generally, the proposed activity comprises construction of a new two storey ambulance station providing for eight ambulance parking bays, and associated works, including: tree removal, car parking, hardstand, access/driveway, and ancillary infrastructure.

The ambulance station will be delivered (as a separate project) through the Rural Ambulance Infrastructure Reconfiguration (RAIR) program.

While this proposal does not require development consent, we are required to assess its likely impacts in accordance with Part 5 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. In accordance with Clause 2.13 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021*, we are notifying the NSW State Emergency Service of our intention to carry out the activity and ask that you provide any comments on the proposal within 21 days from the date of this letter. These comments will then be considered in our assessment of the proposal.

It is noted that the proposed development is located on the fringe of the mapped Probable Maximum Flood (PMF) area, however it is outside of the mapped 1:100 flood event (see attached figure). The development is not considered to affect flood patterns, other than to a minor/inconsequential extent at worst.

For your information, plans indicating the location and extent of the work are enclosed. Generally, the proposed activity comprises construction of a new two storey ambulance station providing for eight ambulance parking bays, and associated works, including: tree removal, car parking, hardstand, access/driveway, and ancillary infrastructure.

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

Notification under section 2.13 of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021 in relation to the New Ambulance Station, Cudgen

Thank you for the notification under sections 2.13 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021* in relation to the proposed Ambulance Station at 771 Cudgen Road, Cudgen. The NSW State Emergency Service (NSW SES) has reviewed the proposed upgrade using the information provided with the proposal and the flood risk information (e.g. local flood Plan, flood studies etc.) available to the NSW SES.

Although the site of the proposed development is on the fringe of the mapped Probable Maximum Flood area, the proposed works appear not to contribute to increasing flood risk. However, the NSW SES encourages Transport for NSW to:

- pursue, if relevant, site design and stormwater management that minimises any risk to the community.
- ensure people using the station are aware of the flood risk.
- develop an appropriate business emergency plan to assist in being prepared for, responding to and recovering from flooding. The NSW SES has a template which can assist in this process: <a href="http://www.sesemergencyplan.com.au/">http://www.sesemergencyplan.com.au/</a>.
