**Arboricultural Report for Nepean Hospital Total Asset Management (TAM)  
Child & Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) project, Kingswood NSW**

An Arboricultural Report was supplied by Moore Trees for the abovementioned project, dated May 2022, issued 23/05/2022. Based on the plans provided, as assessed in the aforementioned Report, Trees 82, 83 and 128-139 are proposed to be removed. All other trees appear possible to retain.

The proposed design for the TAM building has since altered and the Ground Floor General Arrangement Plan by STH Rev A dated 12/08/21 has been reviewed.

I confirm that no additional trees are impacted by the revised design.

However, it is noted that some trees in the car park area have been removed as at the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022. Four (4) trees are remaining of the original eight (8) initially assessed.
