

Decision Statement

In accordance with Part 5, Division 5.1, Section 5.5 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 (EP&A Act), and Part 8, Division 1 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021 Transport for NSW has determined under delegated authority that the activity detailed in Schedule 1 may proceed for the following reasons:

- The Review of Environmental Factors detailed in Schedule 1 examined to the fullest extent
 possible all matters likely to affect the environment by reason of the activity and established
 that the proposal is not likely to significantly affect the environment.
 The Review of Environmental Factors demonstrated that there will not be any significant
 impacts on matters of national environmental significance or any impacts on the environment
 of Commonwealth land.
- 2. The proposed activity is not likely to have a significant impact on the environment and therefore an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.
- 3. The proposed activity will not be carried out in a declared area of outstanding biodiversity value and is not likely to significantly affect threatened species, populations or ecological communities, or their habitats or impact biodiversity values, meaning a species impact statement and/or Biodiversity Development Assessment Report is not required.
- 4. Mitigation measures are required to eliminate, minimise or manage environmental impacts. Mitigation measures are set out in Section 9 of the Review of Environmental Factors referenced in Schedule 1.
