I refer to the abovementioned Development Application referred to Transport for NSW (TfNSW) on 19 November 2021 for comment.

TfNSW key interests are the safety and efficiency of the transport network, the needs of our customers and the integration of land use and transport in accordance with Future Transport Strategy 2056.

Central Coast Highway (HW30) is a classified State road and Masons Parade is a local road. Council is the roads authority for both roads and all other public roads in the area, in accordance with Section 7 of the *Roads Act 1993*.

TfNSW has reviewed the referred information and provides the following comments to assist the consent authority in making a determination:

- It is noted the proposed Lot 2 has a boundary with York Street (State Road). Any future requests for access to the State Road network would not be supported as access is available via the local road network.
- Council should ensure that appropriate traffic measures are in place during the construction phase of the project to minimise the impacts of construction vehicles on traffic efficiency and road safety within the vicinity.
- Council should have consideration for appropriate sight line distances in accordance
 with Section 3 of the Austroads Guide to Road Design Part 4A (Unsignalised and
 Signalised Intersections) and the relevant Australian Standards (i.e. AS2890:1:2004) and
 should be satisfied that the location of the proposed driveway promotes safe vehicle
 movements.

- Discharged stormwater from the development shall not exceed the capacity of the Central Coast Highway (HW30) stormwater drainage system. Council shall ensure that drainage from the site is catered for appropriately and should advise TfNSW of any adjustments to the existing system that are required prior to final approval of the development.
- All matters relating to internal arrangements on-site such as traffic / pedestrian management, parking, manoeuvring of service vehicles and provision for people with disabilities are matters for Council to consider.
