Description of proposed development

Increase of annual throughput capacity of cementitious material from 500,000 tonnes per annum (tpa) to 1,200,000 tpa.

The development is also classified as integrated development because it also requires an environment protection licence from the Environment Protection Authority under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* and approval from Heritage NSW under the *Heritage Act 1977*.
