## DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION REFERRAL Glebe Island Silos, Lot 12 Sommerville Road, Rozelle NSW 2039, Inner West LGA (DA-188611)

I refer to your letter received by Heritage NSW, then Department of Premier and Cabinet, on 25 March 2022 referring the above-named Development Application (DA) for comment.

The proposal is located within the Bays State Significant Precinct. The proposal is adjacent to two State Heritage Register (SHR) items: Glebe Island Bridge (SHR #01914) and White Bay Power Station (SHR #01015).

The following supporting document provided in the application was subject to review:

• Heritage Impact Statement: Glebe Island Silos SSD-8595604 Victoria Road, Glebe Island (Weir Phillips Heritage and Planning, 2021).

The proposal involves the increase of the annual maximum throughput capacity of cementitious material storage silos and related port facilities at the site. No physical works are proposed.

As the proposal is administrative only, Heritage NSW determines that there are no known historical archaeological 'relics' within the proposal that are likely to require management under s139(1) of the *Heritage Act 1977*.

On behalf of the Heritage Council of NSW, it is recommended that the following condition is included on the Development Application:

## **Unexpected Finds:**

1. The Applicant must ensure that if any unexpected archaeological deposits or relics not identified and considered in the supporting documents for this approval are discovered, work must cease in the affected area(s) and the Heritage Council of NSW must be notified as required by s146 of the Heritage Act 1977. Additional assessment and approval may be required prior to works continuing in the affected area(s) based on the nature of the discovery.

Reason: Archaeological relics are protected under the Heritage Act 1977. Notification of the unexpected discovery of known or suspected relics is a statutory requirement under s146 of the Heritage Act 1977.
