- 1. We have made application for supply to Endeavour Energy, investigate the existing substation capacities with them and have prepared a design based on this information. As we have advised previously, there is no requirement for a substation on this site, as we can get the required supply from the substation located across the road. This was covered in our Concept Report from November 2020.
 - 2. We are not involved in the lighting of the carpark and cannot comment on whatever the Council and Endeavour Energy have agreed to.
 - 3. The X2 fittings are pole lights. The lighting to the pathway complies with the requirements of AS 1158.3.1
 - 4. The X3 is an inground wall washer fitting, intended to illuminate the green wall.
