Notice of exhibition of Development Application
Digital Advertising Signage – Darcy Street Rail Overpass, Parramatta (DA 22/5178)

Thank you for referring the abovementioned application to Heritage NSW for comment.

The proposal involves the installation of two new digital advertising signs on the northern and southern elevations of the Darcy Street overpass.

The subject site is not listed on the State Heritage Register (SHR), however SHR items in the vicinity include:

- Parramatta Railway Station (SHR 00696)
- St Johns Anglican Cathedral (SHR 01805)

Heritage NSW have reviewed the two Heritage Impact Statements (Weir Phillips, May 2022) and advise that they have adequately addressed the impacts of the proposal. Heritage NSW concurs with its conclusion that the proposed digital signage will have a minimal and acceptable impact on the heritage items within the vicinity.
