

## **Operational and Management Details Statement**

Elm Grove Sanctuary primitive campground would operate as a low impact campground where patrons can camp by the beautiful banks of the Goobarragandra river.

As a primitive campground there would be access to communal amenities and land on which camper vans, tents, annexes or other similar portable and lightweight temporary shelters could be installed, erected or placed for short term use.

As the land owner I will be the campground caretaker, making sure that the facilities are maintained and that the impact on the local environment is minimal. As the caretaker, I will also be the Primary fire warden. An extensive fire safety plan is attached with this document.

The campground will be open primarily on public holidays, and school holidays. The maximum number of guests that I would predict at any one time, would be 50 campers, spread over 12 campsites.

As an eco friendly primitive campground, all campers are required to remove all waste on departure, leaving the campsite bare and clean as they find it. In the event that any waste is left behind, then I will dispose of it to Tumut rubbish tip.
