Proposal for Swimming Pool

All excavated material will be disposed of to a recycling site as selected by the builder.

Excavated material will not likely exceed 10 cubic meters as excavation and topsoil

Disturbance is envisaged to be negligible.

The builder shall select from;

ECO CYCLE MATERIALS – WETHERILL PARK

BRANDOWN – EMPS CREEK AND THORNLEIGH

BENEDICTS – CHIPPING NORTON

COLLEX RECYCLING – BELROSE, BOTANY, GREENACRE, MOOREBANK, RIVERSTONE

OR – Selected accredited waste facility closer to the local area.

Recycling and cost-effective use of all materials, to save resources and minimize waste shall be considered at all times.

Waste Management Plan

All material from any demolition.

Will be removed from site accordingly.

All excavated material.

Will be removed from site.

All construction material.

(Such as bricks, off cuts from cladding, timber and roofing, excess concrete and colour bond and timer offcuts etc.) Will be stored separately in a portable waste bin. All excesses removed from site.

Recyclable waste material.

(Such as cardboard packaging, plastic, metal and glass) Will be stored separately in a temporary storage wheelie bin. The excesses will be removed from site using the curb side collection service of the council.

Household waste.

Will be stored separately in council provided bins, collected and recycled using the kerbside collection service of the council.

Waste – ongoing operation.

There will be no additional ongoing burden on existing council waste services.

Dust control.

Measures to prevent the emission of dust or other impurities into the surrounding environment are not required.

Waste contractors.

All selected contractors will be properly licenced for the work they will be required to do.
