Before we proceed, we would like to bring the following regulations which were introduced with NCC 2022, to your attention.

A BASIX is no longer necessary for boarding houses. We assess boarding houses as a Section J Assessment. Specifically, the definition of a BASIX building in the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021 excludes a boarding house, hostel or co-living housing that accommodates more than 12 residents or has a gross floor area exceeding 300 square metres. The only assessment required for a boarding house is a BCA Section J Report. We will soon send you a quote from Gemma for a Section J.
