Letter of Owners Consent: M2 Motorway Signage

Dear Marcus Ray,

Transport For New South Wales (TfNSW) has been requested by Hills Motorway Ltd and its agent, Manboom Signage Partnership Pty Limited (Manboom), to provide owners consent to allow the lodgment of a number of Development Applications (DA) for up to 12 new Digital Out of Home (DOOH) billboard signs to be located on the M2 motorway. Of the 12 proposed DOOH signs, 11 are proposed to be located on existing bridges and one as a new monopole (Eden gardens).

TfNSW has done a high level, desktop review of the 12 proposed sites from a traffic and safety perspective based on preliminary information.
