Description of proposal

The application seeks consent for the erection of new illuminated static advertising signs on the Old Windsor Road pedestrian bridge at Bella Vista. The signs have a visual display dimension of 12.6m x 3.9m. Proposed works involve the removal of the existing signs for remediation works, the re-installation of the signs, and the operation of the signs for a period of 15 years.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the department) has received an amended application for the abovementioned Development Application.
