Deep Soil Zones, specifically (including coordination with CHROFI): <i>The amount of</i> <i>structures (such</i> <i>as stepping</i> <i>stones, furniture,</i> <i>bicycle parks</i> <i>etc.) must be</i> <i>minimised to</i> <i>ensure the little</i> <i>deep soil area</i> <i>provided is</i> <i>maximised for</i> <i>vegetation.</i>	All structures inclusive of bike racks, seating and informal play have been removed from the nominated deep soil areas.

Public Domain, specifically (including coordination with CHROFI): <i>Concerns are raised in relation to the amenity and functionality of the public open space 'Alberto Lane' (between building A, B and C and building D, E and F) given the relocation of plant equipment from the roof top. Further details are to be provides demonstrating the purpose and performance of this public space.</i>	Direct access to the terrace housing has now been provided along Alberto Lane further activating this space. Additional planting and furniture has been provided along with signage and artwork to create a vibrant space for residents and visitors. Coupled with communal open space at the western end to draw people into site.
<b>10. General matters</b> , specifically: <i>The landscape</i> <i>plan is to be</i> <i>updated to</i> <i>provide a</i> <i>minimum</i> <i>300mm green</i> <i>roof growing</i> <i>medium.</i>	Landscape details and sections have been amended to included min 300mm soil depth to green roofs and planters on podium.
