OVERVIEW

This Modification statement has been prepared by *Arch. M. Pty Ltd* to present the proposed Modification to Montessori Learning Tree Childcare Centre (MLTCC) to be located at 79 Bransgrove Road, Revesby.

The proposed modifications are as follows:

- 1. Change elevation colours.
- 2. Add Signage with light.
- 3. Change the Non-accessible roof to a Balcony.
- 4. Cancel 4 staircase windows on the first floor.
- 5. Extend the Lift shaft beyond the roof.
