RE: EXISTING TREE RETENTION- CAPTAIN COOK DRIVE (SOUTHERN) BOUNDARY

Dear Andrew,

Please refer to the amended DA landscape plan set Issue P dated 13-6-2025 and the arborist impact assessment prepared by Green Tree Consultancy dated 10-10-2023.

The existing trees for retention numbers are:

42, 43, 44, 45, 48, 49 , 451, 452, 453, 469, 470, 471, 472 , 486, 487, 488, 489

The allocation of soft landscape area around each existing tree to be retained is sufficient for the tree' survival and growth based on the following factors:

1. Many of the trees to be retained are palm trees. They have small compact root balls and are fully grown.
2. Other larger existing tree species have sufficient soil volume to sustain growth to maturity. These trees are fully grown or close to maturity.
3. The softscape allocated for trees to be retained allows protection of the main structural roots (SRZ) of each tree based on canopy mapping.
