#### Description of development consent

Mixed use development consisting of health services facility, retail premises & residential care facility within a six-storey building with 4 levels of basement parking, demolition & associated works

#### Description of proposed modification

Mixed use development consisting of health services facility & retail premises within a five-storey building with 3 levels of basement including tenancy and parking, demolition and associated works.

The proposed modifications include:

- Removal of basement 4 level
- Removal of level 5
- Reconfiguration of basement 3 to include medical tenancy
- Amend parking provision and layout throughout basement levels
- Removal of residential care facility
- Reconfiguration of ground floor to include medical tenancy, relocated café and associated outdoor seating
- Reconfiguration or internal service areas throughout
