Description of the development consent

To allow for the receival, storage and transport of Lithium-ion batteries (a Class 9 Dangerous Good) at the established cargo storage area.

- indicate whether you 'support' or 'object' to the proposal or if you are simply providing comment.
- the reasons why you support or object to the proposal
