On 26 August 2025 the delegate of the Minister for Planning granted consent for the development application DA 24/19221 (PAN-496150) for Construction and operation of a new 150 kilolitre water supply storage tank and ancillary works in accordance with Part 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 (the Act).

The consent has effect on and from 27 August 2025.

The consent lapses on 27 August 2030 unless the development has physically commenced before that date (in the case of development consent for the erection of a building, subdivision of land or the carrying out of a work) or if the use of land, building or work has actually commenced before that date.

General Terms of Approval for part of the proposed development requiring a Controlled Activity approval under the Water Management Act 2000 from the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW) is incorporated into the conditions of consent.

## Reviews/Appeals

Certain appeal and review rights are available to applicants and objectors following determination of a development application.

The applicant has a right to request a review of the determination under section 8.3 of the Act.

If the applicant is dissatisfied with the determination of the application, the applicant has the right, under section 8.7 of the Act, to appeal to the Land and Environment Court within 12 months of the date the determination was notified or registered on the NSW planning portal.
