Description of proposal

Construction of mountain bike trails. The trails commence around the upper section of the Merritts Gondola lift line (also referred to as the "Schuss ski run"). The BD1 trail departs this general area, traversing the native vegetation and terminates at Friday Flat. The BD2 trail continues down the Merritts Gondola lift line and terminates when it joins the proposed Merritts Intermediate trail (subject to separate DA approval) in the locality.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development. The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the Department) has received a development application for the abovementioned proposal.

The application and accompanying documents are on exhibition from Tuesday 4 February 2025 until Monday 17 February 2025. You can view these documents online at State Development Applications.

At the time of publishing this advertisement, the Minister for Planning has not directed that a public hearing should be held.

Have your say

To have your say on this project, you must lodge a submission online through the NSW Planning Portal before the close of exhibition.

To do this, search for this project at <u>State Development Applications</u> and click on 'Make a submission'. If you think you'll need help making a submission using the portal, it's a good idea to contact Service NSW sooner rather than later. Ensure you give yourself plenty of time to make a submission before the project's exhibition end date.

Before making your submission: You should read the department's:

- Privacy statement at <u>Privacy</u>.

Your submission will be published on the NSW Planning Portal in accordance with our privacy statement and disclaimer and declaration. You can elect to have your name withheld from the published list of submitters. If you choose this option, do not include personal information in the body of your submission or in any attachments as your submission will be published in full.

When making a submission you will be required to include:

- your name and address
- the name of the application and the application number
- a statement on whether you 'support' or 'object' to the proposal or if you are simply providing comment
- the reasons why you support or object to the proposal
- a declaration of any reportable political donations you have made in the last two years (visit <u>Donations and</u> <u>Gift Disclosure</u> or phone 1300 305 695 to find out more)
- an acknowledgement that you accept the department's disclaimer and declaration.
