- (b) Schedule 2 Part A, Limits of Consent A6 is amended by the insertion of the **bold and underlined words** and deletion of the struck out words / numbers as follows:
 - A6. This consent does not approve:
 - (a) vegetation or tree removal with the exception of the 13 trees listed for removal in the Arboricultural Impact Assessment listed in condition A2(d). Tree removal works must be in accordance with the Tree Management Plan in the Arboricultural Impact Assessment.
 - (b) works associated with the installation of any electricity or telecommunications cables to service the site.

Separate development <u>A modification</u> application(s) must be lodged, and consent obtained, for the above works (except where consent is not required under an Environmental Planning Instrument or exempt and complying development applies).

- (c) Schedule 2 Part B, Tree Protection B12 is amended by the insertion of the **bold and underlined words** / numbers and deletion of the struck out words / numbers as follows:
 - B12. Prior to the commencement of any works, a Tree Protection Plan prepared in accordance with Australian Standard AS 4970-2009 'Protection of Trees on Development Sites' must be submitted and approved by the Certifying Authority.

The Plan must:

- (a) be prepared by a qualified Arborist;
- (b) identify all trees surrounding the location of construction activities;
- (c) detail protection measures for trees identified in condition B12(b), with the exception of those identified for removal in the Arboricultural Impact Assessment listed in condition A2(d), to ensure they are retained during construction and operation of the development;
- (d) show the Tree Protection Zones for retained vegetation, amelioration measures if works are to be undertaken within the tree protection zone; and
- (e) identify any stockpiling areas.

<u>Tree protection works must be consistent with the Method Statement in the Arboricultural Impact Assessment listed in condition A2(d).</u>

(d) After Schedule 2 – Part C condition C21, insert new conditions C22, C23, C24, C25, C26 and C27 as follows:

Tree Protection During Construction

- <u>C22.</u> During construction, tree protection measures must be maintained in accordance with the relevant provisions of:
 - (a) <u>AS-4970: Protection of trees on development sites;</u>

- (b) Chapter 39 of Sutherland Shire Development Control Plan 2015; and
- (c) the Arboricultural Impact Assessment listed in condition A2(d).

Tree Replacement

C23. Where trees are removed, replacement trees must:

- (a) <u>be provided at a ratio of at least 2:1;</u>
- (b) <u>be endemic species and selected from Sutherland Shire Council's 'Native Plant Selector'</u> <u>available on council's website;</u>
- (c) <u>meet the requirements for quality tree stock specified in the AS2303:2018: Tree Stock for</u> <u>Landscape Use;</u>
- (d) be of a minimum pot size of 100 litres;
- (e) <u>be located within 100 metres of the signage structure and where possible, positioned to</u> provide screening of the sign from nearby residents; and
- (f) be planted prior to commencement of operation.

Revegetation Management Plan

- <u>C24.</u> A Revegetation Management Plan must be prepared by a suitably qualified and experienced person in native revegetation. The Plan must be prepared and submitted to the Department prior to commencement of operation of the sign. The Plan must address, but not be limited to:
 - (a) <u>details on the species to be planted on-site, ensuring that at least 80% of new</u> <u>understorey plants are endemic species selected from Sutherland Shire Council's 'Native</u> <u>Plant Selector';</u>
 - (b) <u>a description of the monitoring and maintenance measures to manage the planted</u> vegetation to ensure the success of the revegetation outcomes;
 - (c) <u>weed management, including measures to ensure regeneration of weeds does not occur</u> <u>and imported fill, topsoil or landscaping material is free of weeds; and</u>
 - (d) <u>measures for stabilising the cleared area and preventing soil erosion in the revegetated</u> <u>area.</u>

The Revegetation Management Plan must be implemented.

Nest Boxes

<u>C25.</u> Existing nest boxes must be removed prior to tree felling. The nest boxes must be relocated within one week of removal and within 50 metres of the felled trees. Removal and relocation must be in the presence of an ecologist.

Works Near Power Lines

- <u>C26.</u> All works adjacent to the overhead power lines must be undertaken in accordance with *Work Near* <u>Overhead Power Lines: Code of Practice (WorkCover, 2006).</u>
- <u>C27.</u> Replacement trees must be planted at a distance so that when full size, they are outside the minimum clearance distance from the power lines, as outlined in *NS220 Overhead Design Manual* (Ausgrid, 2020 as amended on 26/06/2024).
- (e) Schedule 2 Part D, Maintenance Plan D3 is amended by the insertion of the **bold and underlined words** and the deletion of the struck out words as follows:

Maintenance Plan

- D3. Prior to the commencement of use, a Maintenance Plan is to be prepared and submitted to the Department and Council. The Plan shall address, but not be limited to, the following matters, where relevant:
 - (a) Environmental and Safety Risk Assessment;
 - (b) hours of work/inspections of the sign (to ensure minimal disruption of any surrounding residential amenity and traffic operation);

- (c) contact details of site manager;
- (d) safety, including preparation of a Safe Work Method Statement;
- (e) traffic management, including details of the location of parking for vehicles associated with the operation (i.e. parked vehicles shall not impede the movement of traffic or pedestrians in and around the site);
- (f) external lighting in compliance with AS4282: 1997 Control of the Obtrusive Effects of Outdoor Lighting; **and**
- (g) removal of graffiti., and
- (h) maintenance and management of vegetation.
- (f) After Schedule 2 Part E condition E7, insert new condition E8 as follows:

Revegetation Management

E8. Ongoing management of revegetation works must be undertaken in accordance with the Revegetation Management Plan under condition **C24**. End of modification (DA 22/5186 - MOD 1)
