A NABERS Embodied Emissions Materials Form discloses the amount of embodied emissions attributable to the development and is a required document for all nonresidential developments where the <u>State Environmental Planning Policy</u> (<u>Sustainable Buildings</u>) 2022, Chapter 3 applies. The report must be certified by an engineer, qualified designer, quantity surveyor, or NABERS Assessor and should include a bill of quantities.
