To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with the submitted development application we provide the following information:

Building Description

- 7m x 7m x 2.7m high flat carport
- Basalt Monoclad Roof
- Approx. 1mt from front of house, 1.71m from Eastern Boundary and 1.77m from Southern Boundary as per site plan

Site Suitability

- The present land use is residential (R1 General Residential) and the surrounding blocks are residential
- There are no known site constraints and the land is not bushfire prone

Current and previous uses

- The present land use is residential (R1 General Residential)
- The adjoining blocks are also residential
- It is not expected that there is any contamination on the block

Operational details

- The carport is proposed for storage of vehicles

Access and traffic

Increases to traffic movements are not anticipated

Air and Noise

- As the carport is to protect the vehicles from weather, there should be no impact on the surrounding properties

Privacy

- It is not expected that privacy will be an issue for the neighbouring properties

Visual impacts

- There will be no impact of the building on views of neighbouring properties
- There will be no overshadowing of neighbouring properties

Other environmental considerations

- There will be minor earthworks and excavation for small footings materials will be disposed of correctly
- Any excess rainwater will run into the current storm water
- Construction will be completed during daylight hours only with a staff of a maximum of 5 people
- Construction materials from on site will be recycled where possible
- The development is deemed to comply with the relevant NSW Environment Policies
- No constraints are envisaged and the site has been deemed suitable for the proposed development
- The environmental impacts have been identified by the completion of a site inspection by the builder.

The environmental impact of the proposed development has been minimised due to limiting the working hours during construction.
