Description of proposal

Construction of a 5-storey residential flat building (to be used for affordable housing), including:

- site preparation works, including demolition of all existing structures and removal of 33 trees
- construction of a 5 storey residential flat building, comprising:
 - 26 residential units (17x 1-bedroom units and 9 x 2-bedroom units)
 - one level of basement car parking for 12 vehicles
 - private and communal open space area, and
 - associated landscaping, waste storage and civil works.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the department) has received a development application for the abovementioned proposal.
