Could you please provide some advice, or pass my query onto someone in the RFS assessment team who could assist with my query prior to us lodging a DA

KT are proposing some minor internal / external works on two premises in the Thredbo Alpine Hotel. Draft plans attached. The Hotel contains a mix of building classes. These premises are class 6, but the hotel also contains class 3.

I understand under Section 6.5 of PBP, the replacement of a window, glazed area or door must not be increased in size. See image, and details below of door to be replaced. The current door is less than 850mm and will be increased to 920mm.

Yellow – no changes

- Red door increased in size to meet BCA minimum standards
- Purple glass panes to be replaced/reduced in size to allow for increase in door width
- Blue minor works to timber panel to allow for larger door
- No structural works



Is there any flexibility under Section 6.5 of PBP, or would this scope require RFS referral and a BFSA?
