1. Site Overview

- Property Size: Approx. 15,000m²
- Primary Use: Bulk landscape supply, recycling and material processing yard
- Infrastructure: Site office, storage bins, hardstand areas, trucks and machinery
- Access: Main gate via Jarrick Way (ensure gate is always unlocked during fire season for emergency access)

2. Bushfire Risk Assessment

4. Preparedness Measures

Bushfire Emergency Plan

- Maintain a cleared perimeter of at least 20 metres
- Store all flammable liquids in approved containers
- Keep access tracks clear and minimum 4m wide
- Maintain all machinery and vehicles
- Install or maintain a 10,000L water tank with RFS fittings

5. Emergency Procedures

If a Bushfire Is Approaching:

- Monitor Fires Near Me app or ABC Radio (97.3 FM)
- Shut down operations and begin evacuation
- Activate sprinklers or hoses if safe
- Relocate vehicles and flammables
- Staff must report safe exit to site manager

Evacuation Plan:

- Exit via Jarrick Way to Urana Road
- Vehicles face outward for quick departure
- Assembly Point: Clear area near entrance gate

6. Post-Fire Recovery

- Do not return until advised by emergency services
- Inspect for hot spots and damage
- Notify insurance and begin cleanup with caution
- Review and update the plan based on learnings
