## Description of proposal

Construction of a new mountain bike trail called the Enchanted Forest, an Air Flow style trail that includes a combination of rolling contours, berms, tabletop jumps and flowing turns. The trail links the Flow Trail, above the Cat Shed and Snowgums Chairlift Lovers Leap mid-station to the top of the Bobshred and Home Run trails.

### **Nominated Integrated Development**

The proposal is classed as integrated development under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* as approval is required from the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW) under section 91 of the *Water Management Act 2000* 

#### About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development. The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the Department) has received a development application for the abovementioned proposal.

- an acknowledgement that you accept the department's disclaimer and declaration.
