**Re: Development description – Stanbridge Solar Farm
125 Briggs Road, Stanbridge NSW 2650**

Habitat acts on behalf of ANZA Power (formerly Bison Energy) in relation to a Development Application for land at 125 Briggs Road, Stanbridge NSW 2650.

The purpose of this letter is to address the draft conditions of consent as outlined in the Development Assessment Report DA 134/2025 uploaded to the Planning Portal on 24 June 2026 under PAN-591356.

The applicant has reviewed and is supportive of the additional conditions of consent as outlined in the report dated 24 June 2026.

The proposed development as included on page 1 of the Development Assessment Report is:

5 MW elect generating works facility+10MWh battery energy storage.

ANZA Power has confirmed that, due to technology upgrades of the battery energy storage system (BESS) units, there is greater storage density within the internal battery racks, which increases the storage capacity to 25.7 MWh. The proposed development will utilise the same four BESS units as originally assessed — it is only the storage capacity within that is changing due to the product efficiencies.

To reflect this minor amendment, we respectfully submit that the description of the development be updated to:

5 MW electricity generating works facility and a battery energy storage system (BESS) with a capacity of 25.7 MWh.

This revision to the battery storage capacity does not have implications for the physical layout of the proposed solar farm. The location of the BESS station is unchanged. The proposed four (4) BESS units and dimensions of the prefabricated containers will remain unchanged.

A BESS capacity of 25.7MWh within the scope of proposed infrastructure will enable the solar farm to supply the local electricity network, generating renewable energy to support the surrounding network system strength. This storage capacity will support uninterrupted operations such as irrigation pumps and packing sheds while also contributing to the stability and resilience of the local energy system.
