Description of the development consent

Use the existing hardstand area as port facilities for the storage of freight, including the loading and unloading of freight on the site.

Description of proposed modification

The proposed modification is to expand the existing site boundary of the Mayfield Cargo Storage Facility to the south-west (the expansion area), increasing the storage area for general cargo, including lithium-ion battery units, by approximately six hectares.

About the exhibition
