

Project update:

East Seaham Rd, East Seaham Road reconstruction works

Project overview

We've been planning the East Seaham Road, East Seaham reconstruction works, from the northern most sealed section to the Port Stephens boundary of Dungog Shire Council. This project has been made possible with funding via the Federal Blackspot project, Federal Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) funds and committed funding from the \$10M NSW government election commitment.

What's next

We've completed the initial design and planning and have identified that we need to undertake further flora and fauna environmental surveys. Over the next couple of months, there'll be consultants undertaking these surveys on East Seaham Road.

When we've completed the planning process, finalised the design and have approvals to begin, we'll let you know the construction timeframes.

In the meantime, we'll be installing guardrail and enhancing line marking along the existing northern sealed section of East Seaham Road.
