	3. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:		
	(a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available within 6 weeks of the week following the date of the Gateway determination and for a minimum of 28 days; and		
	(b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public		
	exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made		
	publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Planning and Infrastructure 2013).		
	4. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act:		
	Energy Australia		
	 Sydney Water Roads and Maritime Services 		
	Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.		
	5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2) (e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).		
	6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.		
	Plan making delegation The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. As the planning proposal was subject to a pre-Gateway review an authorisation for council to exercise delegation should not been issued.
