### Planning proposal to amend The Hills Local Environmental Plan 2012

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 10 December 2012 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land at Windsor Road, Kellyville from R2 Low Density Residential to R3 Medium Density Residential.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I understand that Council has now provided the department with a project timeline to accompany the planning proposal, consistent with *A Guide to Preparing Planning Proposals*. The project timeline is to be placed on public exhibition with the planning proposal.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under s54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

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## **Gateway Determination**

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP 2013\_THILL\_001\_00: to rezone land at Windsor Road, Kellyville from R2 Low Density Residential to R3 Medium Density Residential.

I, the Director General, Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to The Hills Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to rezone land at Windsor Road, Kellyville from R2 Low Density Residential to R3 Medium Density Residential should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to amend the 'statement of objectives' 1. within the planning proposal to clearly advise that the rezoning will only apply to part of Lots 1, 2 & 3 DP 135989, part of Lot 122 DP1113073 and part of Lot 1001 DP1132811 as shown on the draft land zoning map. Council should amend the planning proposal to clearly advise of the intended outcome of the proposed rezoning.
- Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental 2. Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
  - the planning proposal must be made publicly available for 28 days; and (a)
  - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2012).
- Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the 3. EP&A Act:
  - Transport for NSW
  - Roads and Maritime Services

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material. Each public authority is to be given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal, or to indicate that they will require additional time to comment on the proposal. Public authorities may request additional information or additional matters to be addressed in the planning proposal.

- A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under 4. section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the 5. date of the Gateway determination.
