## FLOWER POWER SITE - NO. 27 MITCHELL STREET CROYDON PARK

It is acknowledged that Council has received the Gateway Determination dated 7 February 2014 for the Planning Proposal to rezone land at 27 Mitchell Street Croydon Park from part R2 Low Density Residential and part IN2 Light Industrial to R1 General Residential, and increase the Maximum Building Height to 11m and Floor Space Ratio to 1.2:1.

After the Gateway Determination was issued, the Mayor of Burwood sought information from the Department, regarding whether Council is in a position to stop the proposal from progressing further. The advice from the Department is that Council may, at any time, request the Minister to determine that a planning proposal not proceed.

Based on this advice, Council considered a Mayoral Minute at its meeting of 17 February 2014 and resolved, in part, that:

- "2. Council stop this proposal by writing to the NSW Department of Planning advising them that Council does not support and does not wish to proceed with the Gateway Planning Proposal for the following reasons:
  - a. The significance of this local employment/business centre within our Municipality.
  - b. The affect on local employment and the potential loss of jobs.
  - c. The overall affect on traffic and parking, thus increasing the burden on traffic in Burwood and around the Burwood Town Centre as residents from Croydon Park/Enfield will have to travel to Burwood for basic needs and groceries.
  - d. NSW Department of Planning take into consideration the fact that we are meeting our housing targets under the NSW Metro Strategy and there is no further pressure for additional housing.
  - e. The need to protect the low density residential character of Enfield.
  - f. The large amount of community concern and opposition to this proposal.
  - g. The fact that moving forward with a proposal that allows three levels of unit development would not be in the public interest of the overall Burwood Community."
