The Planning Proposal should proceed subject to the following conditions:

1. Council is required to prepare and exhibit a Stage 1 Site Contamination Report in accordance with the requirements of State Environmental Planning Policy (SEPP) No 55 -Remediation of Land. The report is to address site contamination issues for the entire site.

2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:

(a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for 28 days; and

(b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 4.5 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning 2009).

3. Consultation is not required with any public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).

5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
