Gateway Determination

Planning Proposal: to permit retail premises with a maximum FSR of 1.5:1 along a section of Parramatta Road in Auburn.

I, the Deputy Director General, Plan Making & Urban Renewal as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (the "Act") that an amendment to the Auburn Local Environmental Plan 2010 to permit retail premises with a maximum FSR of 1.5:1 along a section of Parramatta Road in Auburn should proceed subject to the following requirements:

the matter is not required to be re-submitted;

community consultation is not required before consideration is given to the making of the proposed instrument;

State or Commonwealth public authorities are not required to be consulted;

a public hearing is not to be held by the Planning Assessment Commission, or any other specified person or body; and

the timeframe for completing the LEP is 2 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
