### Planning Proposal to amend the Heritage Schedules of Parramatta LEP 2011 and Parramatta City Centre LEP 2007

Parramatta City Council on 28 November 2011 considered a report on the results of a comprehensive heritage review of heritage items in the relevant planning instruments for the Parramatta LGA and resolved:

- (a) **That** Council agree to the proposed alterations for adding and removing heritage listed items described in Attachments 1 and 2 subject to the removal of the Parramatta Wetlands from the list of items to be removed and the removal of 45 Chiswick Road, South Granville from the heritage list.
- (b) **That** Council agree to the proposed alterations for removing heritage listed items, which have previously been approved for demolition, as described in Attachment 3.
- (c) **That** Council agree to the proposed alterations for correcting anomalies of heritage listed items as described in Attachments 4 and that the CEO be authorised to make any necessary corrections to the property descriptions of heritage items, without further reporting to Council.
- (d) **That** Council make a recommendation to the Heritage Council of NSW for the addition of items of State significance described in Attachment 5 to the State Heritage Register.
- (e) **That** the proposed alterations in (a), (b) and (c) together with the proposed heritage changes in Epping, including extension of the Conservation Area, as described in Attachment 1, be incorporated in a planning proposal to amend Parramatta Local Environmental Plan 2011 and Parramatta City Centre Local Environmental Plan 2007 and be referred to the Department of Planning and Infrastructure for gateway determination.

Subsequently, Council on 27 February 2012 considered a report to rectify errors in the recommendations for the heritage listing of certain items in Epping and resolved:

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- (a) **That** Council agree to remove 41 Kent Street and 51 Willoughby Street, Epping from the list of items to be added to the heritage schedule of Parramatta LEP 2011.
- (b) **That** Council agree to include 17 Grandview Parade and 61 Kent Street, Epping in the list of items to be added to the heritage schedule of Parramatta LEP 2011.
- (c) **Further, that** the planning proposal to amend the heritage schedule of Parramatta LEP 2011 be modified to reflect the proposed alterations in (a) and (b).

The planning proposal has been prepared in response to Council's resolutions which provide for the addition and removal of heritage listed items, the extension and creation of conservation areas in Epping and also the correction of heritage anomalies.

Please find attached the planning proposal and supporting information, for gateway consideration.

Planning Proposal to amend the heritage schedules in Parramatta Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2011 and Parramatta City Centre LEP 2007

#### Introduction

The planning proposal explains the intended effect of and justification for, proposed amendments to the heritage schedules in Parramatta LEP 2011 and Parramatta City Centre LEP 2007. Following a comprehensive heritage review the planning proposal provides for the addition and removal of certain heritage items from the above plans and for the correction of heritage listing anomalies. The planning proposal also seeks to extend the Epping Eastwood Conservation Area and to establish the Boronia Avenue Conservation Area. The planning proposal has been prepared in accordance with Section 55 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 and the relevant Department of Planning and Infrastructure guidelines including 'A Guide to Preparing Local Environmental Plans' and 'A Guide to Preparing Planning Proposals'.

#### **Objectives or intended outcomes**

To:

- 1. Add a number of heritage items to Schedule 5, Environmental Heritage of Parramatta LEP 2011.
- 2. Remove a number of heritage listed items from Schedule 5, Environmental Heritage of Parramatta LEP 2011 and Parramatta City Centre LEP 2007.
- 3. Correct a number of listing anomalies in Schedule 5, Environmental Heritage of Parramatta LEP 2011 and Parramatta City Centre LEP 2007.
- 4. Extend the Epping/Eastwood Conservation Area and establish the Boronia Avenue Conservation Area in Parramatta LEP 2011.

#### Explanation

1. It is proposed to add 12 heritage items to Schedule 5, Environmental Heritage of Parramatta LEP 2011, as outlined below and shown on maps at Attachment A.

#### Justification

#### 1. Is the planning proposal a result of any strategic study or report?

#### Background

The planning proposal has been the result of a comprehensive heritage review. Detailed assessments have been undertaken by Council's heritage consultant on items proposed to be added or removed from the schedules of environmental heritage.

#### Addition of items

The 12 items proposed to be added to the heritage schedule of Parramatta LEP 2011 have significant heritage values that meet NSW Government listing criteria, as outlined in the detailed heritage assessments undertaken by Council's heritage consultant included as Attachment 6. The Epping heritage changes also have significant heritage values that meet NSW Government listing criteria as outlined in the detailed assessments undertaken by a number of heritage consultants and a review by the Government Architects Office included as Attachments 12, 13 and 14.

#### Removal of items

The eight items proposed to be removed from the heritage schedule of Parramatta LEP 2011 meet the NSW Government criteria for delisting, generally having lost integrity or context, as outlined in the detailed heritage assessments undertaken by Council's heritage consultant included as Attachment 7.

#### Removal of 45 Chiswick Road

It should be noted that Council resolved to remove 45 Chiswick Road, South Granville from the schedule of heritage listed items. Reasons in support of Council's decision are:

- The proposal is only for the removal of one house, 45 Chiswick Road from a group of houses including 27, 29, 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43, 45 and 47 Chiswick Road. The other houses will continue to show evidence of significant historical development for the local area and demonstrate the historical design and construction practices relating to The Housing Commission without 45 Chiswick Road.
- The design of the house can be recorded and the building fabric is not required to be retained.
- The house faces design and structural problems. Being situated in the middle of the block the house is difficult to extend. The house has been built on a slope and water run-off drains under the house pooling underneath the main bedroom causing structural damage. It will be expensive to undertake the necessary repairs and to create a home that meets the needs of the present landowner.

• Whilst this and adjoining houses have historical value, the retention of fibro houses is a challenge when they are no longer seen as a preferred building type by many in the community and when people are seeking to replace them with more modern homes which meet contemporary needs.

#### Removal of demolished items

Investigations have identified items which should be removed from the heritage schedule because Council has previously approved the demolition of buildings on these properties. Information supporting the removal of these items is included at Attachment 3.

#### Correction of heritage anomalies

It is proposed to correct heritage listing anomalies, as identified in section 5 of the explanation, which generally involves rectifying property addresses and descriptions to reflect the curtilages of the heritage items.

### 2. Is the planning proposal the best means of achieving the objectives or intended outcomes or is there a better way?

The planning proposal, involving statutory amendments to Parramatta LEP 2011 and Parramatta City Centre LEP 2011, is considered the only means of achieving the objectives and intended outcomes.

#### 3. Is there a net community benefit?

The planning proposal would have a net community benefit in achieving good heritage outcomes that would be of benefit to the community of the Parramatta Local Government Area. Items of heritage value would be added to the schedule of heritage items, items no longer of heritage value would be removed and heritage listing anomalies would be corrected.

#### 4. Is the planning proposal consistent with the objectives and actions contained within the applicable regional or subregional strategy (including the Sydney Metropolitan Strategy and exhibited draft strategies)?

The addition of items to the heritage schedule is consistent with the general objective in the Sydney Metropolitan Strategy to:

#### Protect places of special cultural, open space and heritage value.

The proposals for the extension and creation of conservation areas in Epping is consistent with the following strategy of the Sydney Metropolitan Strategy:

H4.1 Identify heritage landscapes in Sydney and develop appropriate responses to plan for their protection and interpretation in the preparation of Subregional Strategies and LEPs

The planning proposal, is based on a comprehensive heritage review consistent with the following objective of the draft West Central Sub Region Strategy:

WC E6 1.3: 'Local councils to review heritage studies as part of preparing their principal LEPs'.

5. Is the planning proposal consistent with local councils Community Strategic Plan, or other local strategic plan?

The planning proposal is consistent with Council strategic plan, Parramatta 2025 in that it would:

Protect and celebrate Parramatta's rich multilayered built and cultural heritage (DC 2).
