Dear Mr Corcoran,

Planning proposal to amend Corowa Local Environmental Plan 2012

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 26 April 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land near the 'Rivalea' feedmill site, Corowa from RU1 Primary Production to IN1 General Industrial and R5 Large Lot Residential and amend the minimum lot size for the land, insert clause 7.11 'Rivalea feedmill facility buffer area' and a Clause Application Map and identify the land on the Urban Release Area Map.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

Council may still need to obtain the Director General's agreement to satisfy the requirements of relevant S117 Directions. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_COROW_002_00): to make various amendments to Corowa LEP 2012.

I, the Executive Director, Rural and Regional Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Corowa Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to rezone land near the 'Rivalea' feedmill site, Corowa from RU1 Primary Production to IN1 General Industrial and R5 Large Lot Residential and amend the minimum lot size for the land, insert clause 7.11 'Rivalea feedmill facility buffer area' and a Clause Application Map and identify the land on the Urban Release Area Map should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the planning proposal to include the Lot and DP descriptions for all land subject to this proposal. The planning proposal is also to include existing and proposed land zoning, lot size, urban release area and clause application maps, which are at an appropriate scale and clearly identify the subject land.
- 2. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the project timeline within the planning proposal to include all relevant information consistent with Section 2.6 Part 6 of the *A Guide to Preparing Planning Proposals*.
- 3. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).
- 4. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and/or to comply or demonstrate consistency with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
 - Office of Environment and Heritage (regarding the proposed buffer area requirements)
 - Department of Primary Industries Agriculture (S117 Directions 1.2 Rural Zones and 1.5 Rural Lands)
 - Trade and Investment Resources and Energy (S117 Direction 1.3 Mining, Petroleum Production and Extractive Industries)
 - Murray Catchment Management Authority

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

5. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).



6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
