### Planning proposal to amend Lismore Local Environmental Plan 2012

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 11 July, 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to make 'housekeeping' amendments including correcting anomalies to zoning, the Land Use Table and maps, to include additional land on the Land Reservation Map, introduction of a 'sex services premises' local clause and to modify Schedule 2 Exempt Development signage provisions for portable footpath signs.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I have also agreed the planning proposal's inconsistencies with S117 Directions 1.1 Business and Industrial Zones, 1.2 Rural Zones, 1.5 Rural Land, 3.4 Integrating Land Use and Transport, 3.5 Development Near Licensed Aerodromes, 4.3 Flood Prone Land and 5.3 Farmland of State and Regional Significance on the NSW Far North Coast are of minor significance.

In relation to S117 Direction 6.2 Reserving Land for Public Purposes, I have agreed to the reduction of land for public purposes. No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

Council may still need to obtain the agreement of the Director General to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions, for example S117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the

Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

## **Gateway Determination**

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP\_2013\_LISMO\_006\_00): to make 'housekeeping' amendments including correcting anomalies to zoning, the Land Use Table and maps, to include additional land on the Land Reservation Map, introduction of a 'sex services premises' local clause and to modify Schedule 2 Exempt Development signage provisions for portable footpath signs.

I, the Regional Director, Northern Region at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Lismore Local Environmental Plan (LEP) to make 'housekeeping' amendments including correcting anomalies to zoning, the Land Use Table and maps, to include additional land on the Land Reservation Map, introduction of a 'sex services premises' local clause and to modify Schedule 2 Exempt Development signage provisions for portable footpath signs should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental 1. Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
  - the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days;
  - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013); and
  - include existing and (where applicable) proposed land zoning, height of buildings and lot size maps, proposed acquisition areas on the Land Reservation Acquisition Map, and corrections, which are at an appropriate scale and clearly identify the subject sites.
- Consultation is required with the NSW Rural Fire Service (S117 Direction 4.4 Planning for 2. Bushfire Protection) under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act. The Fire Service is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.
- 3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
