Revised Planning Proposal for 396 Bells Line of Road, Kurmond

I am writing in regard to the revised planning proposal submitted by Hawkesbury City Council to rezone land at 396 Bells Line of Road, Kurmond, NSW.

I have determined under section 56(2) that the revised planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached revised Gateway determination.

The Minister delegated his plan-making powers to councils in October 2012. I note that Council has accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of this proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

I note that Council has now provided sufficient information to establish the planning proposal's consistency with S117 Directions 1.3 (Mining, Petroleum Production and Extractive Industries) and 6.2 (Reserving Land for Public Purposes). No further approval is required in relation to these Directions.

The Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the attached Gateway determination. Council should commence exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made to Parliamentary Counsel's Office six weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department for administrative purposes.

Gateway determination (amended)

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_HAWKE_002_00): to amend Hawkesbury LEP 2012 to apply a new minimum lot size and maximum lot yield to land at 396 Bells Line of Road, Kurmond.

I, the General Manager, Metropolitan Delivery at the Department of Planning and Environment, as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to Hawkesbury Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to apply a minimum lot size of 2000m² and a maximum yield of 32 lots to land at 396 Bells Line of Road, Kurmond should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Additional information regarding flora and fauna is to be placed on public exhibition with the planning proposal.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **14 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Infrastructure 2013)*.
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
 - NSW Trade and Investment;
 - Transport for NSW Roads and Maritime Services; and
 - NSW Rural Fire Service.

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material. Each public authority is to be given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal, or to indicate that they will require additional time to comment on the proposal. Public authorities may request additional information or additional matters to be addressed in the planning proposal.

- 4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge the RPA from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing.
- 5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **9 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
