Planning Proposal (PP_2014-_MURRA_002_00) to amend Murray LEP 2011 – Amend Schedule 1 Additional Permitted Uses to include 'Vehicle Body Repair Workshop' on Lot 1 DP 222761, No. 75 Meninya Street, Moama.

I refer to your letter of 19 September 2014 requesting a Gateway Determination under section 56(1) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) with respect to the planning proposal to amend Schedule 1 Additional Permitted Uses to include 'Vehicle Body Repair Workshop' as an additional permitted use with consent on the land known as Lot 1 DP 222761, 75 Meninya Street, Moama.

As a delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway Determination (**Attachment 1**).

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to Councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's Planning Proposal and have decided to issue authorisation for Council to exercise delegation and make this plan (**Attachment 2**).

The amended Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 9 months of the week following the date of the Gateway Determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's office (parliamentary.counsel@pco.nsw.gov.au) 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment (westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.ay) for administrative purposes.

The amended LEP maps and GIS data is to be uploaded to the Departments FTP site at <a href="mailto:the-number of-number of-num



State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEP's by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 57(2)(d) of the EP&A Act is the time frames outlined in the determination are not met.

In accordance with 'A guide for the preparation of local environmental plans' attachment 5 – Delegated plan making reporting template (**Attachment 3**) is enclosed for Council's information. Table 2 of the attachment is to be completed and included in Council's section 59 submission and forwarded to the westernregion@planning.nsw.gov.ay when requesting the planning proposal to be finalised.

Gateway Determination

Planning Proposal (Department Ref:PP_2014_MURRA_002_00): to amend the Murray LEP 2011 -Schedule 1 Additional Permitted Uses to include 'Vehicle Body Repair Workshop' as an additional permitted use with consent on the land known as Lot 1 DP 222761, No. 75 Meninya Street, Moama.

I, the General Manager, Western Region at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Murray Local Environmental Plan 2011 (LEP) to amend Schedule 1 Additional Permitted Uses to include 'Vehicle Body Repair Workshop' as an additional permitted use with consent on the land known as Lot 1 DP 222761, No 75 Meninya Street, Moama should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental 1. Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act) as follows:
 - the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of 28 days; (a)
 - the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public (b) exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).

No consultation is required with public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act.

- A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under 2. section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- Prior to submission of the Planning Proposal under section 59 of the EP&A Act an 3. Additional Permitted Use Map to clearly identify that an Additional Permitted Use applies to the subject land is to be prepared and be compliant with the Department's "Standard technical requirements for LEP Maps".
- The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date 4. of the Gateway determination.
