Mapping Correction Planning Proposal, Section 73A Amendment to Orange Local Environmental Plan 2011 – Amendment 5

Introduction

This Planning Proposal seeks approval for a housekeeping amendment to the Orange Local Environmental Plan 2011 (LEP 2011) to amend the Land Zoning Maps for the site (part lot 300 DP 883628). It is submitted by Orange City Council as the proponent.

The land that is the subject of this Planning Proposal consists of an irregular 'elbow or boomerang' shaped strip of land of variable width fronting Leeds Parade (i.e. the land shown highlighted on figure 1. As part of preparation of Amendment 1 this land was shown on exhibition documents as being rezoned from RE1 Public Recreation to IN1 General Industrial

To amend the Land Zoning map, sheet LZN_008C, of the Orange Local Environmental Plan 2011 to rezone an irregular shaped section of Lot 300 DP 883628 from RE1 Public Recreation to IN1 General Industrial.

The planning proposal is the best known means of achieving the intended outcomes.

Yes. The result of the planning proposal will enable Council to dispose of a small amount of land that is not suited to public recreation purposes, thereby slightly reducing Council's maintenance costs.
