Dear Amanda,

It is understood that the Hills Council is seeking confirmation that the E2 area will be rehabilitated in accordance with E2 objectives.

It has been well established that the subject site has significant environmental values, including the Sydney Turpentine Ironbark Forest (listed Critically Endangered Ecological Community under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* and the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Act 1999*) within the proposed E2 land.

The proposed 600 dwelling masterplan accommodates the minimum required APZs from the E2 land and all other identified bushfire hazards. It should also be noted that the minimum required APZs also result in a maximum Bushfire Attack Level of BAL 29 for the future buildings.

There are no bushfire management requirements applicable to the proposed E2 land and consequently it can fully comply with its corresponding environmental conservation objectives.
