The planning proposal is inconsistent with the Direction as it may res in a reduction in the total potential floor space area for industrial uses in the zones. The because the consent authority must not grant development consent to development unless it is satisfied the development is compatible with the flood behaviour resulting in detrimental increases in the potential flood affectation of other development or properties. The Director Regions, Western can be satisfied that the inconsistency is considered to be of minor significance as the additional land affected is limited to four allotments (Lo 264 DP 41288, Lot 12 DP 667572, Lot 1 DP 957171 and Lot 1 DP 185089).
