Re: Lismore LEP 2012 Fourth Round of Reclassifications – Planning Proposal

Council considered a planning proposal to reclassify two Council owned sites (three allotments) at its ordinary meeting of 14 February 2017. Council seeks to reclassify both of the sites from *community* to *operational*. A brief background of the sites is provided below:

Site 1 – 36A Smith Street, Clunes: Council resolved on 11 June 2013 to reclassify the land from *community* to *operational* in order to transfer ownership of the land to Clunes Community Pre-School. It has become evident that the recent reclassification of the site to *operational - no interests changed* should have been reclassified *operational – interests changed* in order to remove the public reserve status of the land. In order to achieve the correct classification for this site, Council resolved to reclassify the land back to *community* at its ordinary meeting of 14 February 2017 (not an LEP amendment.

Site 2 – 2 and 4 Cassia Crescent, Goonellabah (part Clifford Park): Council resolved on 10 May 2016 to reclassify the two adjoining lots from *community* to *operational* to facilitate the potential lease or ownership transfer of 2 Cassia Crescent to Jarjum Pre-School. 4 Cassia Crescent would provide access and potential car parking for 2 Cassia Crescent.

Council's resolution of 14 February 2017 regarding the reclassification planning proposal is provided below:

That Council:

- 1. Adopt the reclassification of Site 1 36A Smith Street, Clunes (Lot 2 DP 830616) from operational to community.
- 2. Adopt the planning proposal as detailed in Attachment 1 to reclassify:
 - Site 1 36A Smith Street, Clunes (Lot 2 DP 830616) from community to operational interests changed
 - Site 2 2 and 4 Cassia Crescent, Goonellabah (Lot 1 and 2 DP 630988) from community to operational no interests changed.
- 3. Forward the reclassification planning proposal as detailed in attachment 1 to the Department of Planning and Environment for a Gateway determination.
