Proposal Summary: This Planning Proposal seeks to amend the Gunnedah LEP 2012 by:

- rezoning part of Lot 662, DP 39633 and part of Lot 680, DP 723481, Gunnedah, (299 Kamilaroi

Road) from E3 Environmental Management to R5 Large Lot Residential; and

- amending the minimum lot size map for part of Lot 662, DP 39633 and part of Lot 680, DP

723481, Gunnedah, (299 Kamilaroi Road), from 40ha to 1.2 ha.

Supporting Reasons: This Planning Proposal will facilitate the development of more rural residential housing

on land that is currently zoned for this use. It will also facilitate the efficient use of Council water services infrastructure. The potential impact on the environment is

considered to be minor in nature given the size of the land involved.

1. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:

9 months

- (a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2013) and must be made publicly available for a minimum of 14 days; and
- (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2013).
- 2. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
- **NSW Rural Fire Service**
- Office of Environment and Heritage

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

- 3. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 4. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 9 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
