Planning Proposal PP_2017_KEMPS_007_00 to amend Kempsey Local Environmental Plan 2013

I am writing in response to Council's request for a Gateway determination under Section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act), and additional information received on 3 August 2017, in respect of the Planning Proposal for three housekeeping amendments.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the Planning Proposal's inconsistency with Section 117 Direction 4.1 Acid Sulfate Soils is justified in accordance with the terms of the Direction. No further approval is required in relation to this Direction.

Council will still need to obtain the agreement of the Department's Secretary to comply with the requirements of relevant Section 117 Directions 1.3 Mining, Petroleum Production and Extractive Industries and 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

I have considered Council's request for delegation and determined not to issue an authorisation as this proposal is the first to incorporate the SEPP (Integration & Repeals) Schedule 1 provisions into the LEP and as such the Department would like to oversee drafting of this particular plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's

request for the Department of Planning and Environment to draft and finalise the LEP should be made 8 weeks prior to the projected publication date.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under Section 54(2)(d) of the Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.
